SOME househunters love the vaulted ceilings and space that come with a barn conversion.

Others worry about being able to make it homely enough, or heat it properly.

So for anyone who's not quite sure how they feel about actually living in a barn conversion, renting one might prove the ideal solution.

The first, in Wytham, includes four bedrooms and two bathrooms.

There is a large living room with vaulted ceilings, exposed

It is surrounded by beautiful countryside and is near Wytham Woods, so ideal for a peaceful stroll on a warm evening.

The second barn conversion is set in two acres of land near Faringdon with far-reaching views over countryside.

The property has six bedrooms, with a balcony off the master suite and four

bathrooms. There are three reception rooms, a separate study and a large kitchen/breakfast room with a range cooker.

The house also has a generous-sized garden, which agents say would be perfect for summer, plus off-road parking for several cars.

Under the tenancy agreement, tenants are expected to use a gardener.

Despite its rural location, the barn conversion is close to the A34 for an easy commute to Oxford, Abingdon, Witney and Swindon.
