AN APARTMENT in a grand country house set in five acres near Bicester is available to let. Cotmore House in Fringford was built in 1866 before being divided into eight individual apartments in the 1940s after the Second World War and still has many period features including high ceilings, curved staircases and carved stonework. The two-bedroom first floor flat
