



This one-bedroom cottage in Shutford has plenty of character

Enjoy good life in cottages for rent near village pubs

MANY people's idea of a rural idyll is to be able to walk from their home to the local pub.

Oxfordshire is the ideal spot to make this dream come true as there are so many pretty villages.

Two cottages available for rent allow tenants to do just that, as each is just a one-minute walk from a pint of real ale at the local hostelry.

The first is a pretty thatched one-bedroom character cottage in Shutford, near Banbury, which is just 381ft away from the village pub.

The living room has exposed

beams and a wood-burning stove and is separate from the kitchen.

There is one double bedroom upstairs, which has views over the garden.

There is a small lawn at the front and the back garden includes a patio.

Tenants would need to use on-street parking.

The cottage is available to let, unfurnished immediately at £760 per month.

The second property with a pub nearby is tucked down a quiet lane just 341ft away from Greatworth's village inn.

Downstairs is a living room with window seat, an inglenook fireplace and woodburner.

The kitchen/dining room has

a door to the back garden, which has a patio, seating area and good-sized lawn.

There are three bedrooms upstairs plus a family bathroom.

Other highlights include views over paddocks from the front of the property.

Tenants would need to use street parking, say agents.

It is available to let, unfurnished, from the middle of July at £925 per month.

Greatworth is a short drive from Banbury, Brackley and Silverstone.
