Riverside homes snapped up fast in rental market

LIVING on the waterside is never more attractive than in summer months.

Letting agents say apartments at the Old Gaol in Abingdon are almost always snapped up quickly after coming on to the rental market.

Finders Keepers, which has let a number of luxury flats in the converted former jail, says they do not remain on the market for long.

The development, on the banks of the River Thames, is just a short walk from the town centre. Luxury apartments are normally available unfurnished and finished to a high standard, with

contemporary looks mixed with original features.

Another reason why the properties prove popular with tenants, Finders Keepers says, is because their location in the heart of Abingdon offers an easy commute to Oxford and surrounding science parks

Finders Keeper recently let a two-bedroom flat in the complex, which it was marketing at £2,600 per month.

The top-floor apartment was in the original section of the Old Gaol development.

Both bedrooms were doubles and there were two bathrooms.

Other highlights included a breakfast bar, mezzanine level and balcony with views out over the river.

The conversion, which had 2,000sq ft of living space, also

came with secure underground parking and access to a residents'-only gym on site.

The tenancy also included use of a beautiful, communal riverside garden.

Finders Keepers still has one first-floor property available to let at the Old Gaol. The apartment has two double-bedrooms, both with ensuite bathrooms, plus a bright open-plan living room/kitchen with floor-to-ceiling windows and a balcony with views over the River Thames. It is available to let, unfurnished, at £2,400 per month.
