Opportunity to live in Old Gaol apartments

TEN apartments in the original Old Gaol building in Abingdon are available to let.

These include six serviced apartments being offered as short-term options.

The serviced flats are ready to move into and are often seen as an alternative to hotels.

Kitchens are fully equipped with items such as crockery, cutlery and the apartments are kitted out with everything from towels and cushions to pictures and mirrors.

Each apartment has video entry phone system and CCTV and tenants also have use of the secure underground parking and communal gym.

There are also four apartments to let, unfurnished,

for those looking for a longer-term home.

These include a first-floor, two-bedroom flat with high ceilings and a large balcony with views over the river.

Both bedrooms are doubles and both have ensuite bathrooms. It is available to let, unfurnished, at £1,995 per month

Another is a top-floor, two-bedroom flat with mezzanine study levels and the original prison bars on the windows.

One of the bedrooms is ensuite and there is also a second bathroom. It is available to let, unfurnished, at £1,550 per month.

The Old Gaol, built by prisoners from the Napoleonic War, has been developed by Cranbourne Homes.

The complex will also include a cafe and restaurant quarter

and the waterfront area will be reopened to the public.

There will also be new riverside moorings.

All the apartments are being marketed through letting agents Finders Keepers.

Frank Webster, of Finders Keepers, said: "We think that these will prove to be ideal as either short-term or longer-term options to tenants and corporate businesses in Oxfordshire and their clients/employees. We have seen them and they are stunning and finished to a very high standard.

"We are very excited but more importantly, they are exactly the sort of thing that we think might be of interest either as a short-term arrangement or for a longer period."
