These properties offer a taste of life by the waterside

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EVEN though Oxford is one of the most central and landlocked cities in the UK, it is still possible to live in a waterside setting.

Thanks to its abundance of rivers and canals, there are plenty of places which are on or look out over the water.

Two rental properties which tick this box and are stylish places to live are right in the heart of the city. The first is a contemporary two-bedroom flat in Foundry House, Jericho.

The first-floor apartment includes floor-to-ceiling windows with panoramic views over Port Meadow and the canal. Agents say it is

furnished to a high standard with two double bedrooms, one with a walk-in wardrobe, one family bathroom and one en-suite shower room, an open living/dining room and kitchen.

The apartment also has a balcony from both bedrooms and the living room. There is secure underground parking for two cars. But no pets are allowed. The furnished flat is available to let at £2,295 per month from July 22 through Finders Keepers.

The second property is a three-bedroom house in Mill Street which has stunning views of the Thames. The three-storey townhouse on the riverbank is part of the old flour mill, parts of which are Grade-II listed, and was

converted into houses and flats in 2012. The property includes three bedrooms – one with en-suite – and a bathroom. There is also a kitchen with double oven plus off-street parking with space for two cars.

The house also has a balcony and communal riverside garden. Agents say pets may be allowed.
